Financial Obligations 2018-2019

International Dues Assessment: Due October 2018, \$100.00

This payment is passed on to Kiwanis International and funds the leadership training programs, and administrative expenses of the international organization.

Club Quarterly Dues: \$60.00: Due March, June, September, December

The club dues are set annually by the club board of directors. Our dues pay for our leadership training and conference attendance, Key Club support, website maintenance and hosting, additional insurance, postage and administrative support.

Weekly Club lunch Meetings: Vero Beach Yacht Club \$20.00 per lunch

Attendance at lunch meetings is encouraged but is not mandatory. The lunch includes salad, a main, dessert and soft drink. Gratuity is included and you pay only when you attend lunch. The club does not assess fines for missing a lunch meeting.

Kiwanis of Vero-Treasure Coast Charitable Foundation

The club administers a charitable foundation. Our fundraising efforts are added to the foundation. The foundation is a qualified 501(c)3 organization and all donations are tax deductible in accordance with current federal tax law. We encourage all members to participate in our fundraising efforts, whether by soliciting donations, donating time to support our fundraising events or by making a direct tax deductible contribution to our foundation.

Social Events

We do not include a social assessment to our local dues. Therefore, any club social events you attend are on a pay as you go basis. We generally try to hold a couple of social events in each half of the year. We found this is a fair way to approach social activities as typically not all members are available to attend each social event. Once again, you are only paying when you are able to participate.

New Member International Enrollment (One-Time)

Each new Kiwanis applicant will pay \$100.00 to the local club which will be forwarded to Kiwanis International to enroll the Kiwanian in all of the Kiwanis International programs.
